Curriculum Delivery

RATIONALE

Programmes at Alfredton School will give all students the opportunity of a broad and balanced education. It will provide coverage of the eight essential learning areas, and deliver teaching and learning programmes developing the five key competencies with the aim to help students achieve their potential and to inspire lifelong learning.

GUIDELINES

1. Learning programmes will reflect the principles outlined in the New Zealand Curriculum
2. Teachers are required to plan and assess teaching and learning programmes using the school implementation plans and the official curriculum documents
3. Curriculum planning will allow for school wide and inter school activities; eg Sport, Cultural, EOTC visits
4. Outside agencies such as REAP may be used to enhance teaching programmes for all students
5. Years 1 - 8 reflect the requirements of the New Zealand Curriculum.
