SWIMMING POOL

OBJECTIVE

The Board of Trustees must ensure that the swimming pool is kept in a safe and hygienic state.

PURPOSES

1. To provide a safe and healthy environment for the school and the wider community to enjoy both learning and recreational swimming

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Board of Trustees will:

1. Ensure the policy is upheld within the school through regular reporting and monitoring

The Principal will:

1. Develop the necessary procedures to fulfill the requirements of this policy

PROCEDURES

1. Ensure all legal obligations under Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992 and the Fencing of Swimming Pools Act 1987 are met
2. All children under 16 must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times
3. All people using the swimming pool must do so in a responsible manner and with care to make sure that the swimming pool is kept safe and hygienic
4. Pool rules and guidelines for use to be displayed in the pool area
5. Toilets at the rear of the main block to be made available for pool users (Ensure that the door into the main classroom is locked securely each night from the start of the swimming season) If this privilege is abused it is to be stopped immediately. Notice of this is to be placed in the pool area.
6. For out of school hours a key system will be in place
