Christ The King and Marian College. Christ The King has successfully implemented both Writer's Toolbox and iDeal Structured Literacy. It was very informative to see them being taught and to speak with both staff and students about them. We currently use Writer's Toolbox and will be introducing iDeal Structured Literacy.
